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Who can apply?

**Teachers:** registered primary and secondary school teachers from government and non-government schools (anywhere in Australia).

**STEM professionals:** anyone with a STEM qualification and/or experience working in a STEM field (academic or industry based). STEM professionals are required to comply with CSIRO's Child Safe Procedure.
