


STEP 2

From the Education Dashboard click on **Learning Courses** to access the CSIRO Education and Outreach Learning Homepage. From this homepage you can access your online learning programs and your collaborative JAM groups.




STEP 3

To access the CSIRO Education and Outreach Learning Management System (LMS) click on the **My Learning** tile. This will take you to your 'learning page' where you can start or continue the learning programs you have been assigned.



STEP 4

Click on the **View Program** button which will take you to the program agenda, where you can start your program.

To begin your learning module, select the first learning item and click on the **Start Course** button.


Previous and Next buttons

- If the next button is not active, you must complete more tasks on the slide before advancing.



Navigating a CEo learning program

When you complete a learning item and are ready to move onto the next, click on the **Back** button on the Online Content Structure page. This will take you to the program agenda where you can start the next learning item.



Once you have completed each learning item, you can navigate back to your 'Learning page', and you will see the learning items listed in your **Learning History**.




Obtaining a statement of completion

You will need to click on your browser's menu, select **print** and print the statement of completion to PDF. Save the PDF to your computer.
