



Young Future Shapers Terms and conditions

1. Nominees must be residents of Australia.
2. Nominees must currently be in Years 5 to 10 or would be in Years 5 to 10 if they were in the school system this year.
3. Parents can nominate their children.
4. Young people can choose to nominate themselves. All nominations must include parent/legal guardian consent.
5. All applications must include:
 - Basic demographic information about the nominee
 - Contact details for their parent/legal guardian
 - Written or video responses to two questions (maximum 500 words or 3 minutes each), which includes a personal response from the young person.
6. The immediate family members of CSIRO, BHP, or the BHP Foundation employees are not eligible to be Future Shapers. These employees can, however, nominate someone outside their immediate family.
7. If successful, nominees will receive:
 - Support to create a personalised plan,
 - Invitations to virtual group experiences for all Young Future Shapers, and
 - A chosen opportunity (such as a STEM Camp or local excursion), or resources to support them in their next steps in STEM.
8. Each recipient support package will include either in-kind support, experiences, or equipment, paid for by CSIRO Education and Outreach as needed. Recipients will not receive cash. CSIRO reserves the right to define expenditure for the experiences.
9. Year 5, 6, or 7 Young Future Shapers who opt to attend a STEM Camp will need to be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian.
10. Decisions regarding Future Shaper applications are final, and no further correspondence will be entered into.
