



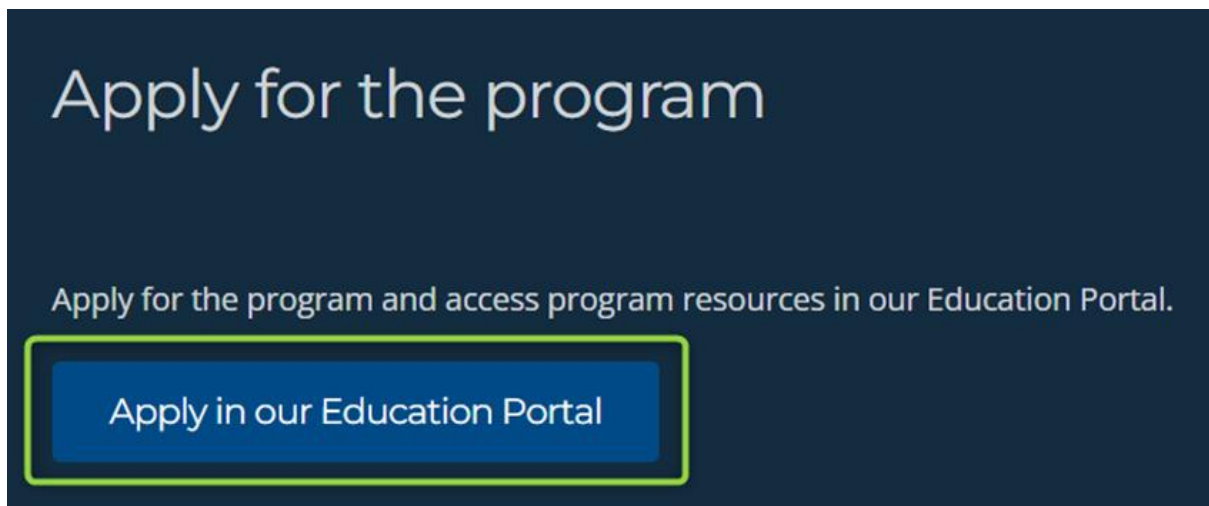
Customer Program Application Guide

Account Set Up

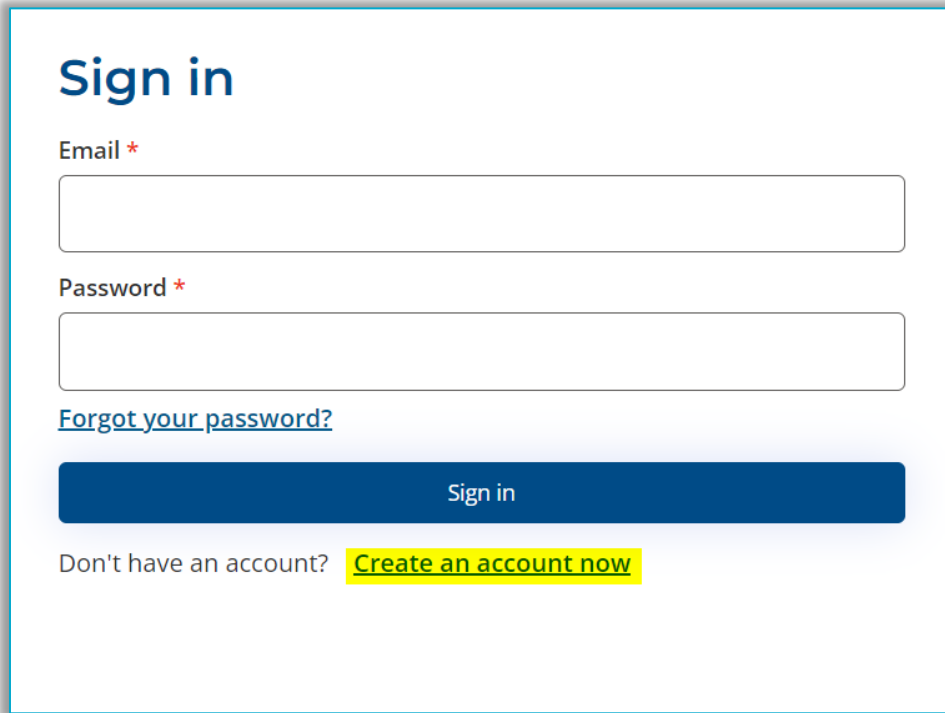
If you are **new to CSIRO Education & Outreach**, jump to [New user account creation](#).

New customer account creation

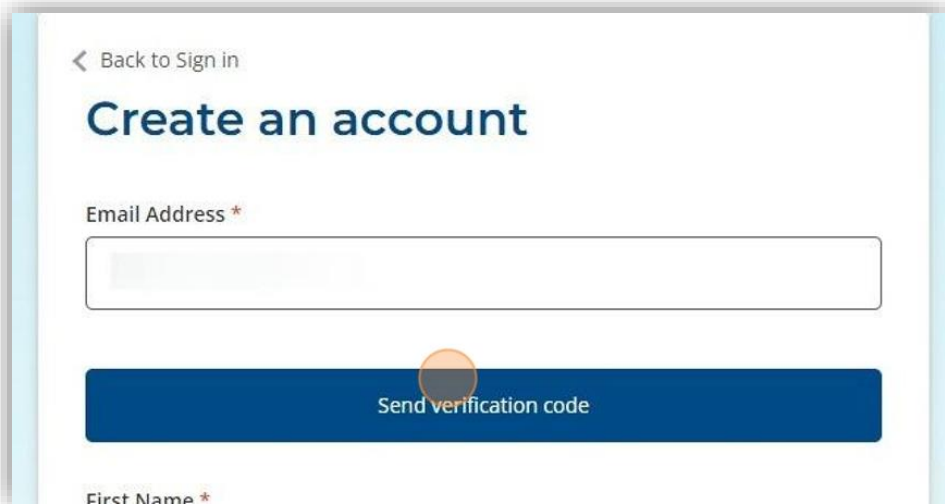
1. To create a new Portal account, select **Create an account now**.

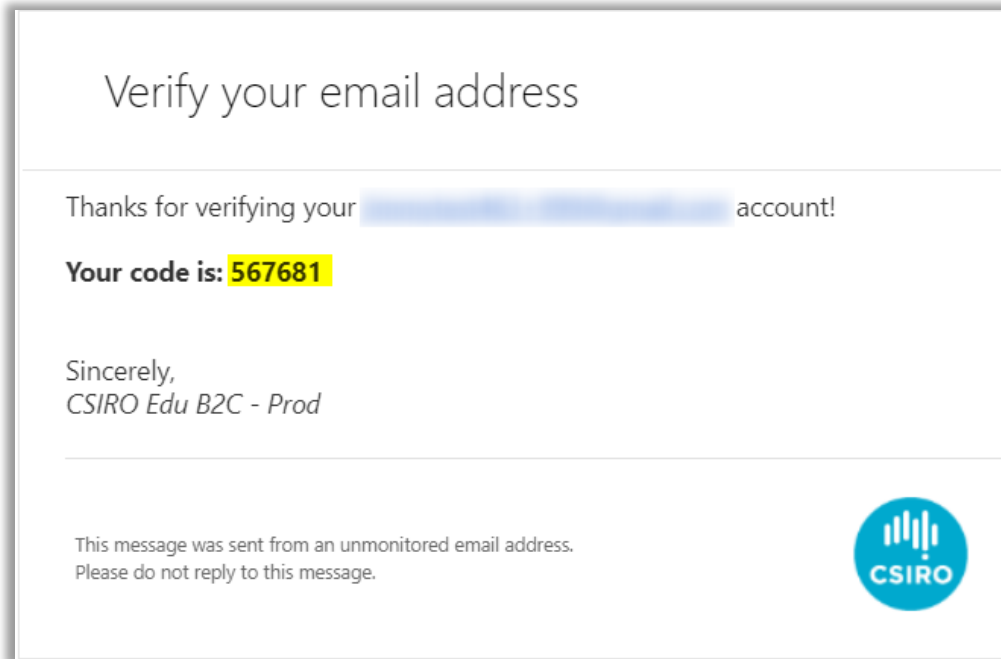
2. Enter your preferred email address and select **Send verification code**.



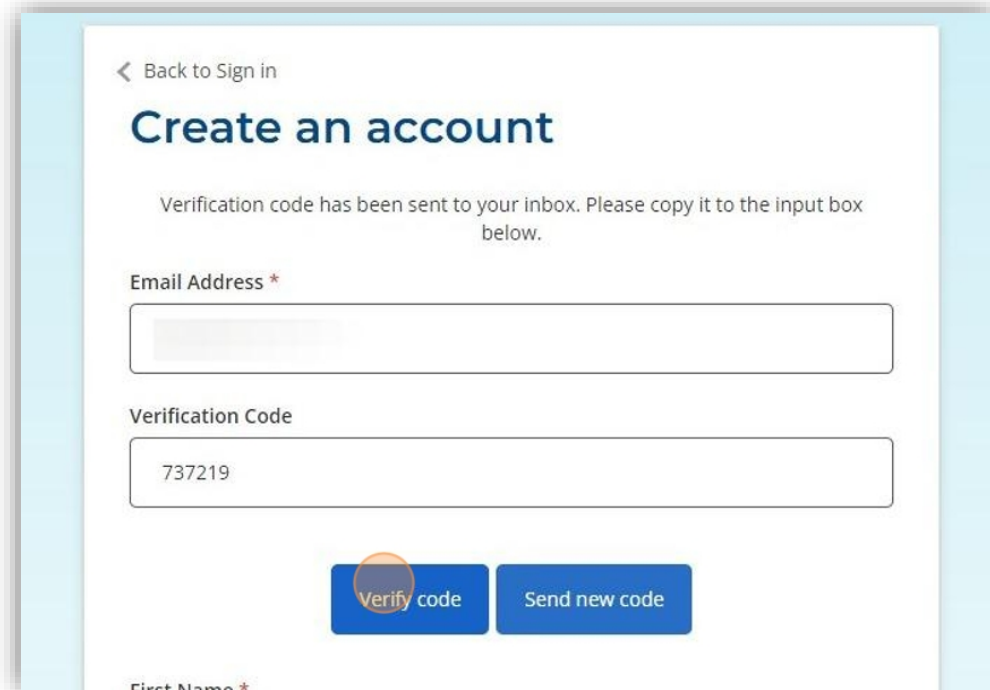

3. In a new tab, new browser or on a different device, navigate to your email inbox. Find the email from "Microsoft on behalf of CSIRO Edu B2C" and copy the verification code.



4. Enter your verification code and select the **Verify code** button.



5. Once your email is verified, complete the rest of the form. Then, after reading the **Terms of Use**, select the checkbox to agree. **Check your details**. If everything is correct, select the **Submit** button.

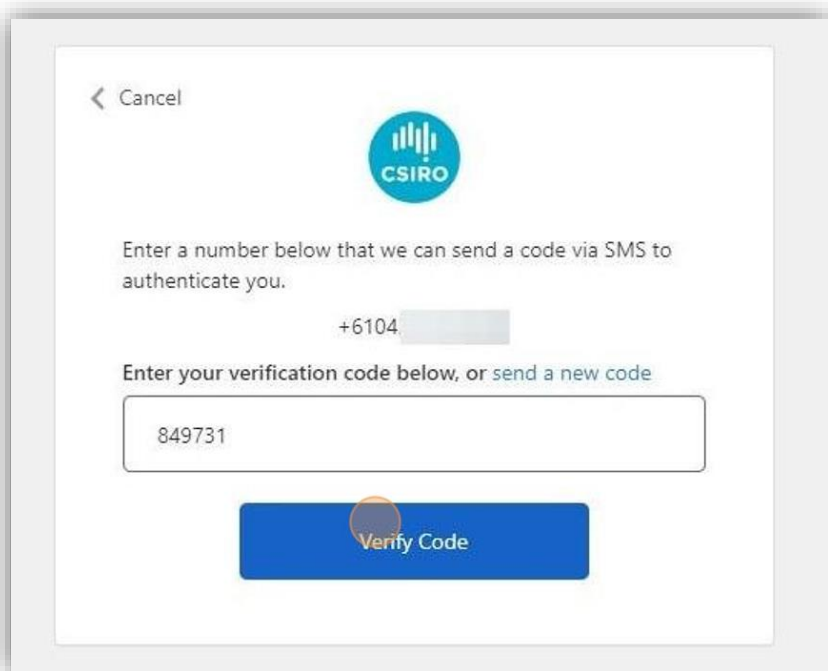
6. Next, enter a mobile phone number that can receive text messages, then select **Send Code**.



Please note:

You will need to access this mobile phone number for your Multi-Factor Authentication each time you access the portal.

7. You will receive a mobile text message from 'msverify'. Enter the 6-digit verification code into the textbox, then select **Verify Code**.



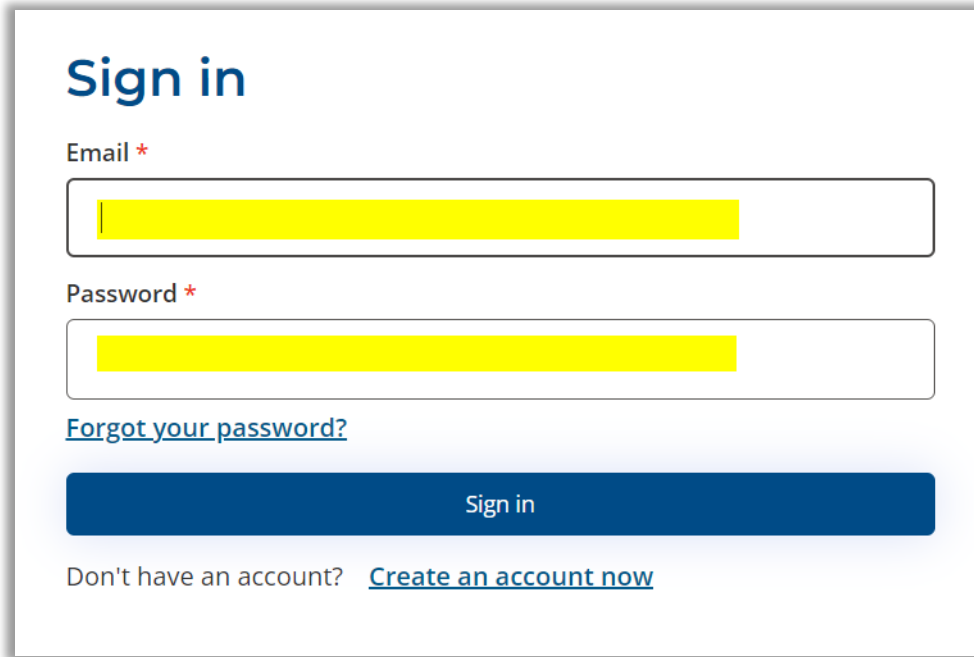
Please note:

The 6-digit authentication code sent to your mobile is a once-only use. You will receive a new code every time you sign in.

Now proceed to the Portal Dashboard instructions on page 12.

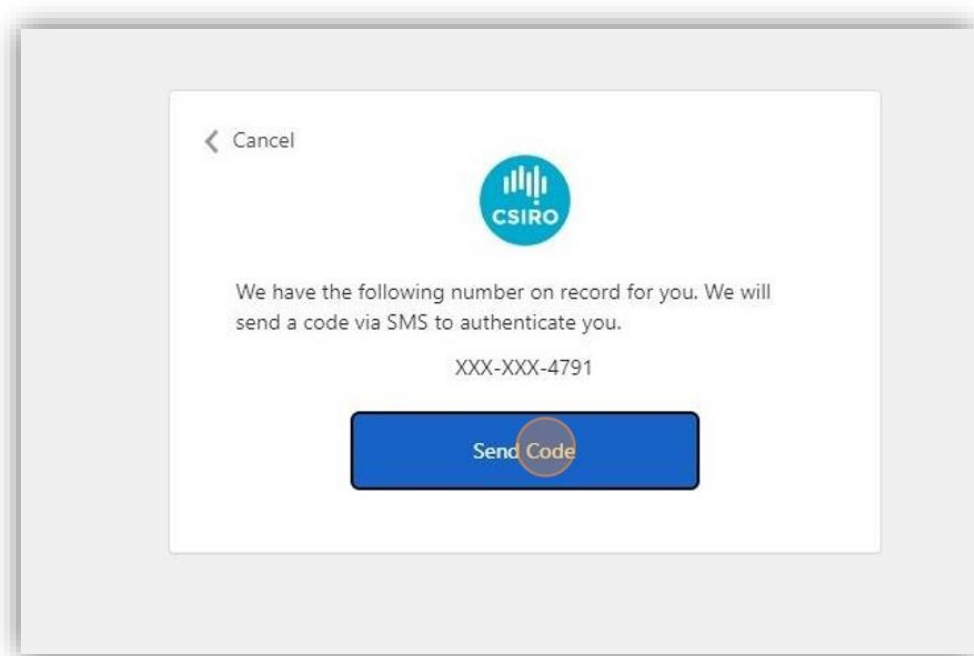
Existing User Sign-In

1. Enter your email address and password you set up previously, then select **Sign in**.



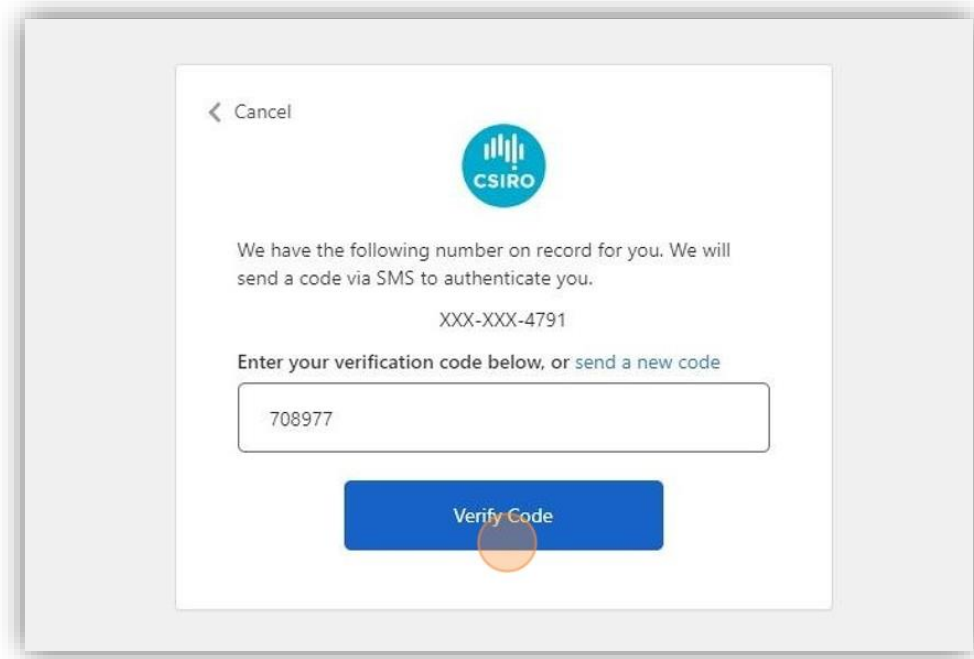

Existing Education & Outreach Customers with no online account

Education & Outreach program officers have, in the past, set up customer profiles directly into our database.

If your information is already in our database but you have never set up an online account with us, simply follow the *New customer account creation* instructions on page 2 of this guide.

Before you do this, please contact your Education & Outreach project officer to ascertain the correct details for your profile. You need to make certain that you use the **exact same** first name, last name and email address that we already have in our system. If your name or email has changed, we can alter those details before you set up your new online account.

Our project officers will ask you some questions in order to conclude you are the rightful owner of the profile details we already have.

Forgot Password

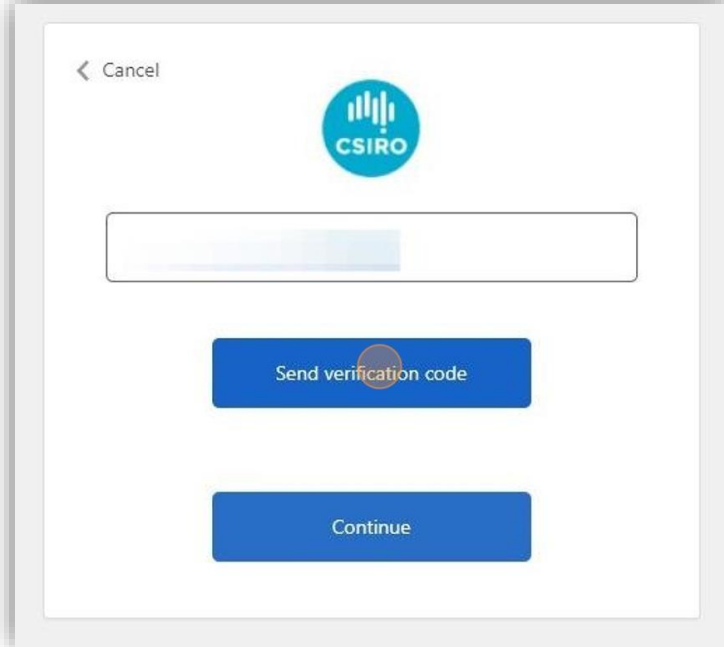
Forgot Password should be used if you already have an account, but you have forgotten your password.

1. Select **Forgot your password?**

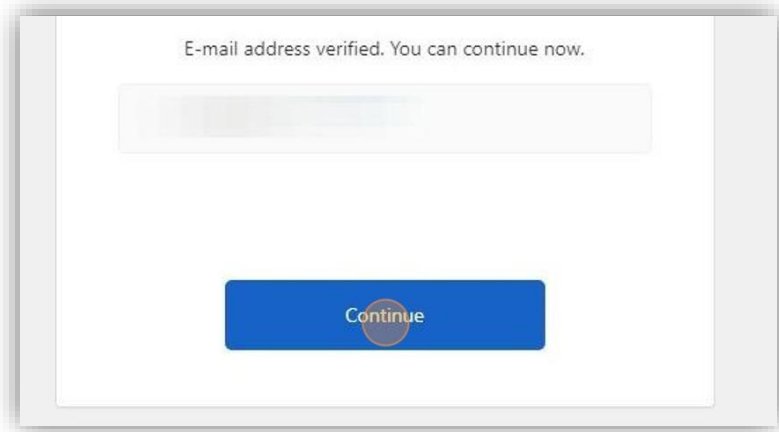

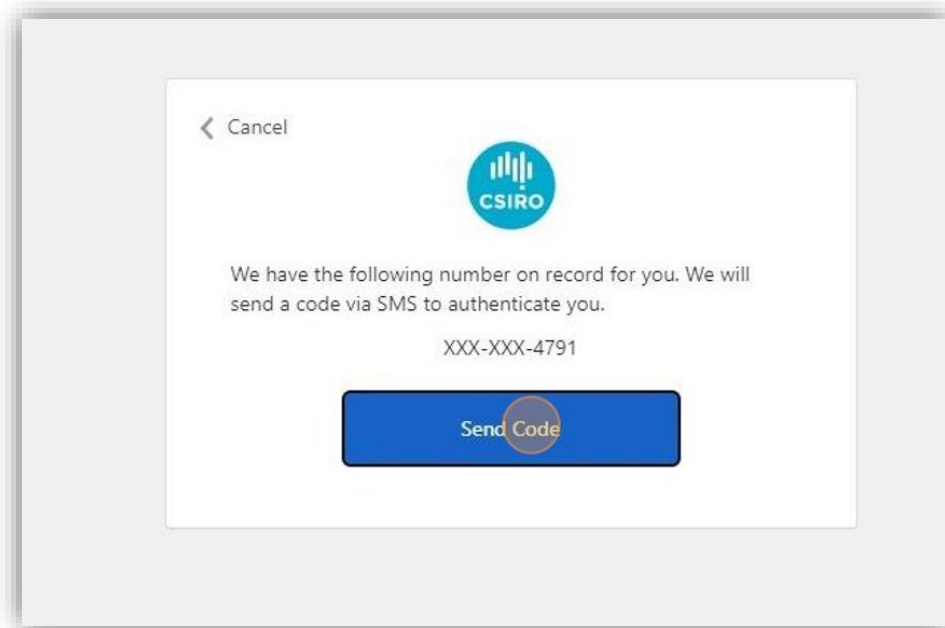

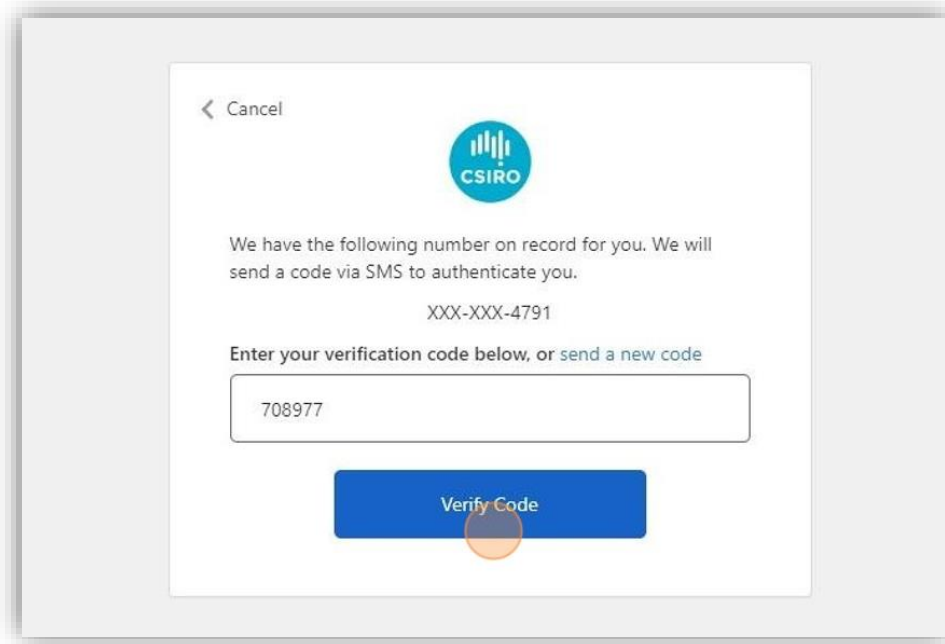
3. Once your email address is verified, select the **Continue** button.



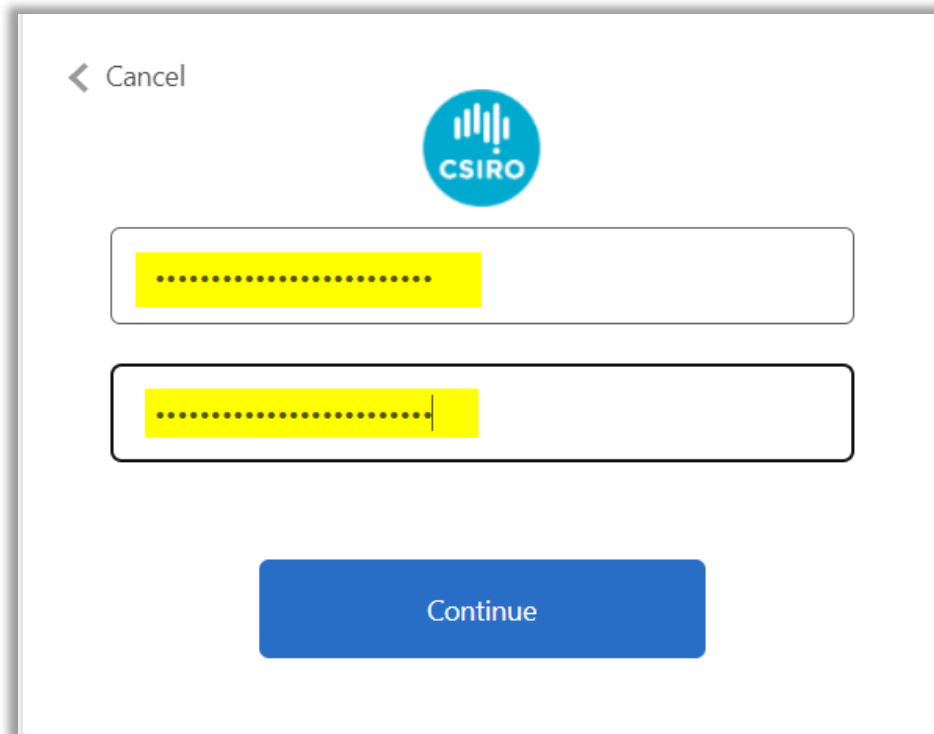
4. The mobile number you provided at initial signup will appear. Select **Send Code**.



5. Next enter your 6-digit authentication code, then select **Verify Code**.



6. Enter a new password then select **Continue**.



Returning to your dashboard

Once you have signed up for an Education & Outreach account, you can sign back in to your dashboard at any time without the need to go through the website. That is unless you want to apply for another program. Then you must apply from the program information website.

1. If you are a volunteer for **STEM Professionals in Schools** or **Generation STEM – CPP** programs, use education.csiro.au
2. If you are a volunteer for **any other program**, use education-2.csiro.au
3. If you happen to have Education program applications in both scenarios 1 and 2 above, swapping between each portal, and therefore your applications, is easy.
 - a. Once you have signed in to either portal, simply open the other portal in a new window and you will be signed in automatically.
 - b. For example, you signed into your STEM Professionals in Schools account using education.csiro.au and you arrived at your SPS dashboard. Now open a new window and use this link education-2.csiro.au. You will land on your other program's dashboard without the need to sign in again.

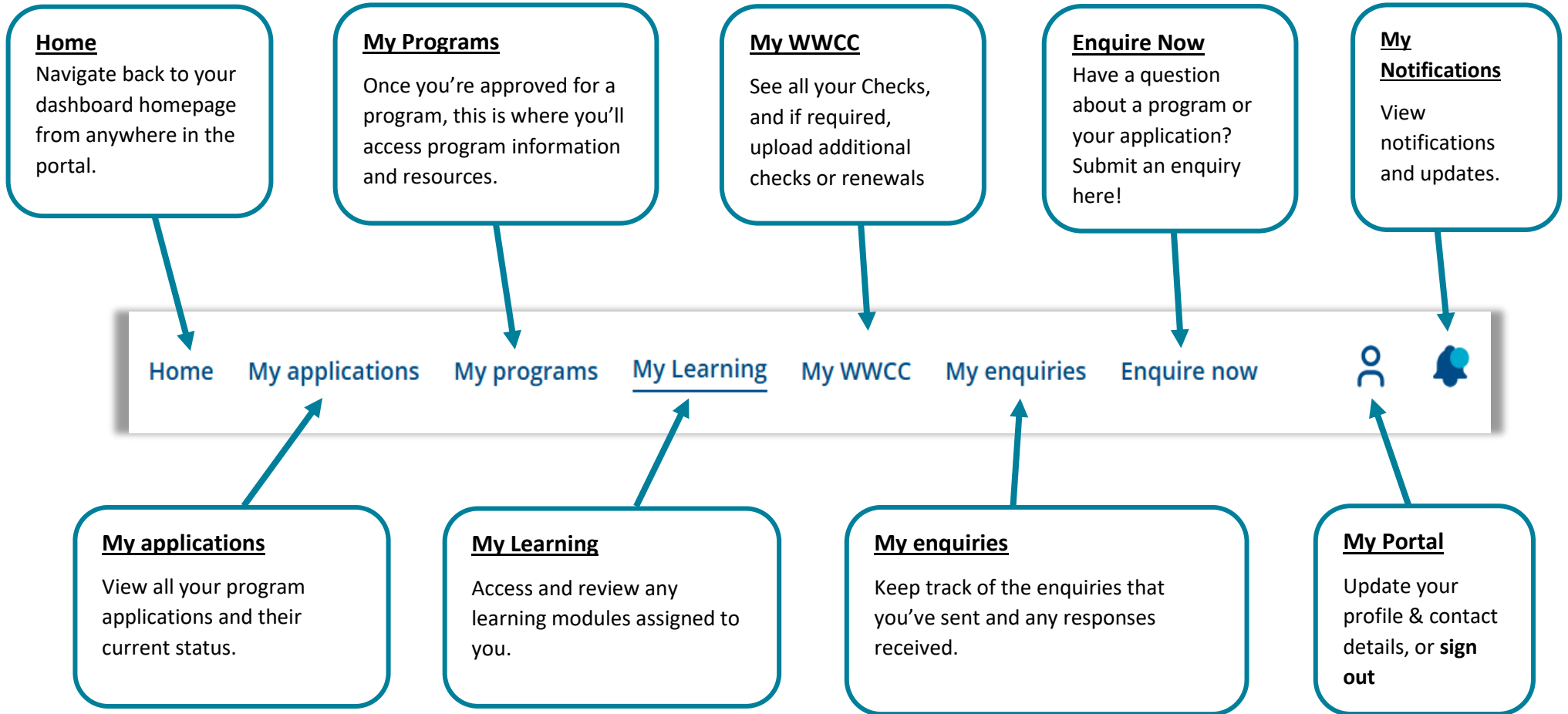

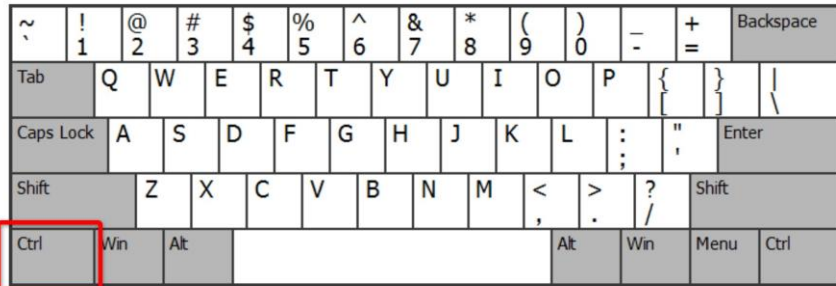

Accessing assigned Learning modules

When a CSIRO Education Officer assigns a learning module to you, you will receive two notifications. One is an email to your nominated email address. The other is a notification in your portal dashboard – the bell icon changes colour. To access your learning, sign in to your portal dashboard and go to the My Learning tab.

Therefore, make sure you **select and hold the Ctrl** key on your keyboard then select the **Access Learning** button. This will open the LMS in a new window while retaining your dashboard in the original window.

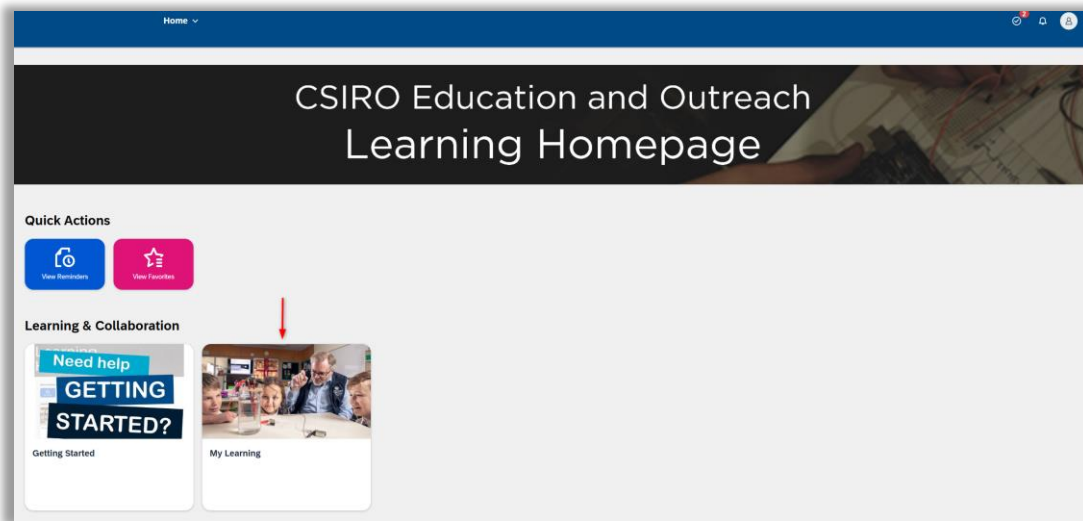

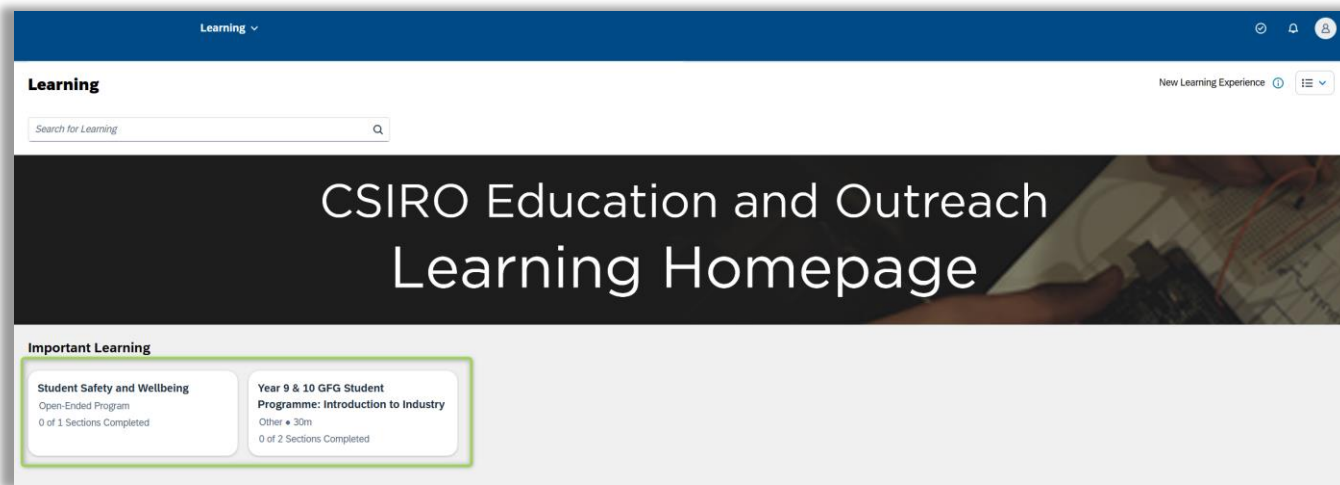

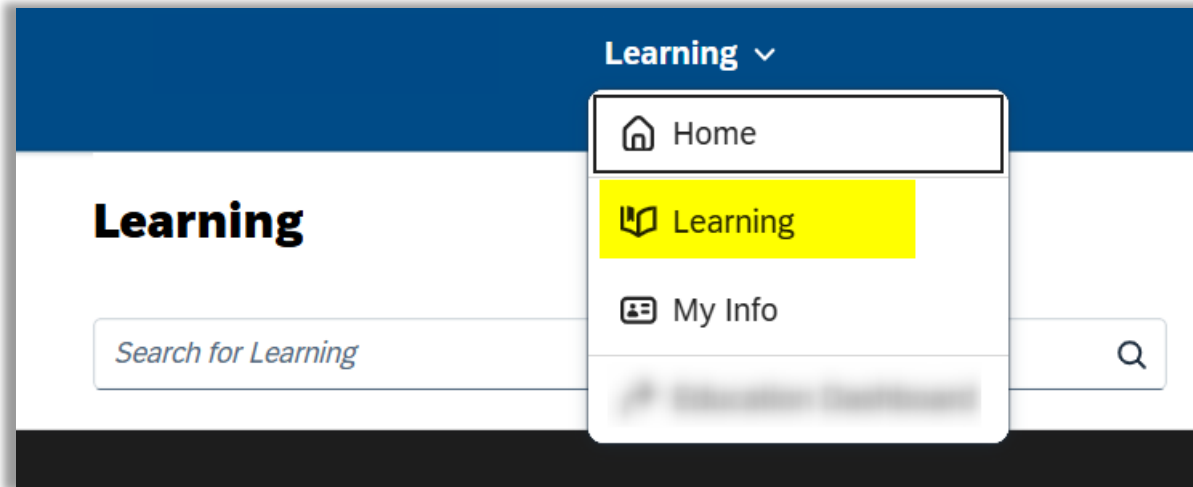
You should now be on the Learning Homepage. Select the My Learning tile.



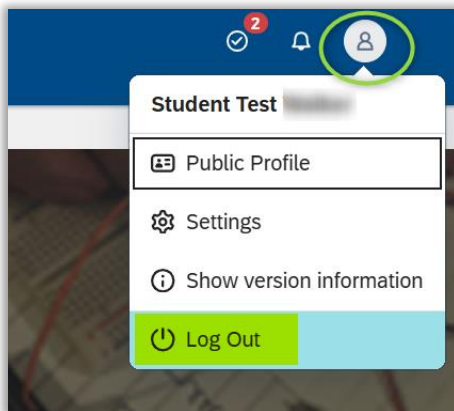
At the bottom of the My Learning page you will see the learning modules that have been assigned to you. Select each one in turn, follow the instructions and complete your learning.



At the top left side of the page, in the blue bar, you will find the **Learning** drop down. When you complete a learning module, open the drop down then select the **Learning** link to return to the Learning page. Start any additional modules.
