# STEM Community Partnerships Program

## Campbelltown local scenario

### Local City Life

Campbelltown City Council has a 20-year plan to increase liveability, enhance sustainability and employment opportunities locally. They hear the comments of the community regarding the closing of businesses, the resulting empty sites in the city area and are keen to create a vibrant and ambient city centre. One way is a program offering grants to make improvements to shopfronts and outdoor trading areas.

The main street of a city can be the centre of the community, but it requires constant review and updating to meet the changing needs of the locals. Over time the street scape can be degraded and not offer facilities to meet their needs. There are many aspects to consider from the appeal of the buildings, providing safe walkways and bike tracks, spaces to meet, adequate and appealing lighting, as well as a range of retail options and business activities. The Committee for Sydney has found that when the right conditions are in place, a healthy main street precinct is self-sustaining.

In addition, COVID-19 has changed the work environment for people with many continuing to have flexible work arrangements which includes working from home or using local workspaces. By reflecting these changes in transport, office facilities and recreation requirements in the local city environment, an economically sustaining precinct for the community can be created.

Campbelltown City Council have the challenge to ensure they provide the relevant services and activities to cater for this problem.
