

Privacy Notice for RESS FSP Energy Storage Competition

This privacy collection notice sets out how CSIRO collects and manages your personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (the Privacy Act).

How and when do we collect your personal information?

We collect your personal information to facilitate your participation in the RESS FSP Energy Storage Competition. CSIRO may collect personal information from applicants, selection panel members, judges, mentors, CSIRO staff and other individuals.

The personal information collected may vary for different individuals, and may include

- your full name
- contact details, such as your email address, mobile or phone number
- where you are located (e.g. what State you reside in)
- your University name, your course/degree type and name

Your personal information will be collected during the application process.

Information may be collected when you

- submit an application via the competition website,
- send us information by email or regular mail.

When we collect your personal information from others

We may collect personal information from third parties involved in the Competition including the judges. This information will only be collected and used for the purpose of assessing the Proposals and facilitating the Competition.

We will not use or disclose your personal information for marketing purposes.

Who do we disclose your personal information to?

We will disclose your personal information to third party entities for the purpose of facilitating and promoting the Competition. These entities include:

Will we send your personal information overseas?

While we will seek to limit circumstances in which information is disclosed overseas, in order to facilitate the Competition, we may send some personal information we collect overseas.

We may disclose your information to third party entities (including those listed in this Notice) who may use data centres located in the United States or other jurisdictions to store personal information.

This means that your personal information may be transferred outside Australia and stored on servers in the United States or in other jurisdictions.

You will be required to confirm that you had read, and agree to, this Privacy Notice before you submit your Proposal.
