



Terms and Conditions for voucher draw

1. The promoter is the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation ("CSIRO") (ABN 41 687 119 230), Clunies Ross Street, Black Mountain, ACT, Australia.
2. Information on how to enter and prize details form part of these Terms and Conditions.
3. Entry to the prize draw is free and open to individuals over the age of 18 who complete the survey and email CSIRO (researchstudy@csiro.au) to register for the draw.
4. By entering the Competition, each entrant agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
5. Entries not submitted in accordance with the Terms and Conditions may be deemed ineligible. Only one entry per email address will accepted into the prize draw.
6. The entry period commences from 12 November, 2021 and concludes on the 30th November, 2021 or when the research project reaches recruitment targets, whichever is sooner.

A total of 50 entries will be selected using a random number generator at the offices of CSIRO Kintore Avenue (or in remote equivalents if working from home due to COVID-19 restrictions), in Adelaide on Wednesday 1st December, 2021. The winner will be notified via email which will also contain the URL link to their \$50 e-gift voucher. This prize is not transferable or exchangeable or redeemable for cash. Total prize pool is valued at \$2500 (50 vouchers valued at \$50 each).
