STEM Teacher Application Form

Application Process

The application process involves one email to indigenous-stem-awards@csiro.au with attachments (see below):

- [Application form](#) (preferably PDF) to be completed by the applicant or nominator, including a privacy statement, eligibility information, personal information, response to the selection criteria (in either written format or by video response to a maximum of four minutes) and supporting evidence.
- [Referee form](#)(s) to be completed by relevant referee(s), to provide recommendations and/or comments on the applicants' suitability for the award.
- Up to two pages of annotated photos (no more than six per page) in .doc, docx or pdf format.
- Profile photo to be used if selected as a finalist. Ideally the photograph should be from the waist up and taken outside. Good luck!

You will receive an email confirming that your application has been received.

All applicants and nominators will be notified about the outcome of the application after the judging period in December 2019.
